Actions from Previous Meeting and Updates

No	Issue	daa response
1.	GOR requested information in relation to the western apron planning process	The West Apron was delivered under Class 32 of Planning and Development Regulations, and as an exempted development, planning permission was not required
2.	GOR asked for information relating to recent developments noted at Gate 11	Activities at Gate 11 relate to construction works associated with airside projects and maintenance; this gate is only used in emergency situations or very exceptional circumstances
3.	MG requested daa to send members notification when the underpass planning application has been submitted	The application has not yet been lodged and we will notify members when it has been
4.	COR asked if a clay bank could be installed at daa lands adjacent Dunbro Lane	There are no plans to install earth berms and the lands in question are under lease to local farmers
5.	COR asked if one of daa's properties on Dunbro Lane could be renovated to accommodate Ukrainian guests	There are no plans to renovate Sandyhill House on Dunbro Lane; daa continues to work with Government agencies to assist as appropriate
6.	LOG requested a comment on how daa intend to comply with Condition 5 when North Runway opens	daa notes this request is also the subject of an Access to Environmental Information request submitted by LOG on 19 May. daa is engaging in that official process and it is not appropriate to comment in another forum at this time
7.	RF had previously requested temporary fencing and breeze blocks be installed at Lots 15 and 16 which are being leased by Irish Water for installation of the new water mains pipeline	These works have been completed
8.	BOD had contacted MM after the last meeting to enquire about weed management measures at Western Compound	Grass cutting and weed management measures have been carried out, as requested

Dublin Airport Update

- Delays in security screening queues have improved and the vast majority of passengers are clearing security in under 30 minutes. Airlines and ground handling companies are experiencing difficulties at Dublin and other airports due to the impact of Covid on staff and industrial action at some European locations.
- Demand is expected to remain high at Dublin Airport over the summer period and we continue to advise passengers to arrive 2.5 hours before a short-haul flight and 3.5 hours before a long-haul flight, with a further hour if checking in baggage.
- Over 2.8m passengers travelled through Dublin Airport in June, which is equivalent to 88% of pre-Covid levels. More than 12m passengers travelled through the airport in the first six months of the year, representing 77% of 2019 levels.
- All payments for this year's first round of Community Funding have been completed and projects are now underway.
- Final quality testing, commissioning and operational readiness trials are almost complete on North Runway in preparation for opening on 24 August 2022.
